- We cannot accept heavy, fragile or easily damaged pieces.
- No pieces may be sold or priced at the event. For anyone wishing to sell pieces, please leave business cards for any potential customers.
- Some pieces may be displayed for an extended period of time (TBA). Any pieces to be taken down after the show must be cleared with Natalie Valentine for a pick-up time.
